SAKI broke alertly pressuring the pace through the turn, shook clear in the two path upper stretch holding sway from the eighth pole. NUIT DE ANGEL hustled out pressured the pace abreast SAKI through the turn, ceded to rival in upper stretch then battled inside of FINAL DECREE salvaging place in the three path. FINAL DECREE a step slow early rallied to contention emerging to threaten in upper stretch, extended in the four path gave all to the end. WILD PACIFIC WAVES slow early gained a bit into upper stretch holding position with even action in the three path. CUJO ANNIE away slowly was never involved circling six wide in upper stretch. TOO HOT BABY breaking alertly pressured early then steadied in close quarters near the seven sixteenths pole fading back along the inside to upper stretch. FLASHY PANTS pressed then chased through the turn, gave way in the four path upper stretch. LETS SNEAK IN struggled throughout.
