RUSSELL ROAD pressured early locking up with JASIZZLE on the turn, wrested a clear lead into upper stretch drawing out in the three and four path late. JASIZZLE hustled up early pressured the pace dueling abreast RUSSELL ROAD on the turn, ceded a clear lead to rival in upper stretch proving no match the final eighth holding as a clear second best. SILVER SUMMATION close early would drop off along the inside on the turn, regrouped somewhat in upper stretch rallying as best of others in the two path. RUMMY'S COMMAND slow early circled out to upper stretch finishing evenly at mid track. VOODOO STORM a step slow early on stayed back through the turn, swung six wide in upper stretch proved no menace. DIXIE JACKPOT pressed early then chased through the turn, faded in the three path upper stretch. HELIOPSIS after breaking well would drop back early being always outrun. TUP TAKE' PLEASE unruly in the gate showed early speed then retreated on the turn. VOUCHER flashed early speed then gave way on the turn.
