STREETFIGHTINMAN sprinted to the early lead under little asking, went in hand on soft splits through the turn, roused hard while widening a bit in upper stretch, dug in under left handed urging to hold sway. FROLIC A LOT sat close up stalking STREETFIGHTINMAN through the turn, pursued all out in drive proving no match while securing place. AFFIRMED FEVER broke alert pursuing STREETFIGHTINMAN from the rail to upper stretch, wore down there under a drive. LIVELY EXIT raced evenly throughout. FAX MACHINE broke well to lay close up, edged to leader looming on the turn, would flatten out at the head of the lane. TALC BOY sent hard along the inside dropping off under the whip on turn. DIAMOND KID failed to respond. MONKEYS UNCLE was always outrun. HANLEY ROAD labored throughout. TRAITOR ON LINE was bumped and jostled between horses at the break.
