Footnotes

NATIVEMAN rushed a three wide bid mid turn, took over and opened up leaving the quarter pole, angled towards the rail in upper stretch, received left handed stick from mid stretch, began to shorten stride a sixteenth out but had enough to reach the wire under strong handling. SPEEDY GRAHAM settled early racing mid track, bid five wide into the lane, surged strongly in deep stretch closing in on a tiring winner, missed in a game effort. BREAKING FREE raced up close along the rail to mid turn, lost position at the quarter pole while angling out, swung six wide upper stretch, surged belatedly in a willing try. FIRST PRIZE TABLED broke alertly taking an immediate lead, headed by the winner mid turn, had little resistance and ceded control, angled out to mid track in upper stretch giving chase, lacked kick and tired mid stretch. FALSE HOPE stalked early, bid three wide at the quarter pole, loomed off the winner turning for home traveling between foes, lacked late bid and tired in the drive. SEE U AT T PARTY was hard ridden shortly after the start but lacked response, settled in the second flight, varied little never threatening. DON'S APOLLO lacked speed and traveled towards the rear throughout, failed to factor. TERLINGUA'S PRINCE was quickly outrun racing mid track, never factored. BUYALILBIT raced briefly in mid pack, steadily faded from the quarter pole.
