RIVER BLADES set a moderate pace traveling a little off the rail, nursed the lead around the turn, was set down racing in the three path in upper stretch, dug in late to prevail under strong encouragement. WRIGLEY IVY tracked down the backside racing mid track, roused from the quarter pole, came four wide taking aim on RIVER BLADES, was inching closer with every stride nearing the finish line but just missed in a hard effort. CUBAN CARMEN was taken in hand stalking early on, sat patient racing between foes on the bend, angled a bit inside upper stretch, put to a drive and finished willingly gaining the show position. AMERICAN ROMANCE raced up close along the rail throughout, began to chase leaving the quarter pole, lacked late kick and was outfinished late vying for a minor award. NAJARANS STAR trailed to the quarter pole, split foes entering the stretch racing five wide, lacked rally despite being hard ridden. SEVEN TIGERS raced five to six wide throughout, was hard ridden to no avail from upper stretch, failed to menace. ELLE SOCIETY stalked the winner to the half, could not keep pace past the quarter pole, faded to last in upper stretch.
