Footnotes

COSSACK DANCER broke well stalking the leader from the start, drew even racing three wide in upper stretch, went head to head with TUESDAY'S CAT from mid stretch, slowly inched clear under an all out drive. TUESDAY'S CAT hustled early, pressed for the lead from the start, hugged the rail vying for the lead leaving the quarter pole, matched strides with the winner to deep stretch, was out nodded in last jumps missing in a very hard effort. SEE THAT DEVIL was forwardly placed around the the turn, came four wide taking aim on top pair, loomed in the final furlong but needed a bit more late. GETTEM READY EDDIE settled in the second flight, advanced mid turn running between foes, bumped a couple of times with S S PATRIOT near the three eighths pole, rallied five wide upper stretch, gave belated surge improving placing. SNOWGRATS was bumped and squeezed leaving the gate, raced well off the rail down the backside, rushed move turning for home, leveled off mid stretch. S S PATRIOT veered out at the break bumping rivals, hustled running towards the inside going into the far turn, was jostled mid turn racing between foes, traveled towards the inside during the stretch run never menacing. ROMAS SPIRIT was hard used setting a pressed pace running in the two path, began to tire mid stretch from earlier efforts. LIGHTING RAY was bumped by S S PATRIOT at the break, trailed down the backside, swung six wide upper stretch being hard ridden, failed to factor. WILDCAT HUMOR lacked speed racing along the rail, was bumped and squeezed taking up at the three eighth pole, swung very wide upper stretch, no factor. HEZA BELFAST raced in mid pack to top of the lane running four to five wide, weakened in the drive offering little.
