BONNISTAR stalked close up pressuring to a short lead in upper stretch, digging in from the four path withstood outside pressure to prevail. DISGUISE well placed stalked through the far turn, rallied in upper stretch bidding abreast BONNISTAR giving all to no avail. QUIET EMARATI raced evenly through the far turn, angled six wide in upper stretch lacked a closing surge. SPIRITWOOD raced mid pack saving ground to upper stretch, angled four wide gave an even finish. COPPER CASCADE played no factor. BUCKEYE SLEW sent clear set the pace through the far turn then wilted in upper stretch. COUNTRY HUMOR was always a step slow. HEADLINE went evenly in mid pack then flattened out in upper stretch. ROAD NOT TRAVELED was always outrun.
