Footnotes

BLYDE RIVER BOY sent hard, cleared mid turn racing in the two path, was kept to task holding safe. BAND PLAYER pressed the winner to mid turn racing along the rail, angled out leaving the quarter pole, gave chase throughout the stretch run, needed more late just holding on to second place. SIR HILLARY was bothered slightly by KING THOU ART who was angling in shortly after the start, settled in the second flight racing towards the inside, was in close upper stretch along the rail, angled out mid stretch, split foes a sixteenth out, found best stride too late surging at the wire to just miss second place. KYLE'S TREASURY raced wide down the backside, rushed bid mid turn, chased in the lane improving position but was no real threat. KING THOU ART hustled leaving the gate, angled towards the inside, bid entering the stretch, flattened out inside the furlong marker. MAJOR STRIKE stalked top pair around the bend, swung out four wide upper stretch, lacked rally and tired in the drive. CAST NO SHADOW trailed running mid track, showed little. TALK TO DA MANAGER was outrun offering little. DAYS OF LIGHTNING lost irons at the start, dropped off to trail turning for home, was eased upper stretch but did complete the course.
