Footnotes

KEEN CASE stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, shaking clear in the three path upper stretch drifted out seven wide late holding off DUKE OF ASPEN in the process. DUKE OF ASPEN slow early advanced from the turn threatening at mid track in upper stretch, pressing the leader was carried out to the eight path by the drifting rival late. DURAND PARK pressured the pace working to put a head in front on the turn, weakened in upper stretch mustering enough to hold position late. FULL HORSE POWER slow early was taken eight wide in upper stretch finishing evenly. JUSTICE EXPRESS broke sharply pressing the pace through the turn, wavered in upper stretch fading in the three path. B L'S SAND SHARK was always outrun. PREDATOR RIDGE displaying poor action was pulled up and vanned off.
