PLASMA BEAM stalked SMARTTHINKIN'TONY down the backside, was mildly urged middle of the second turn, left the field behind from mid stretch to win in hand as much the best. SMARTTHINKIN'TONY hustled to the top, dueled briefly with the winner mid turn, proved no match from upper stretch but did hold well in deep stretch saving second place. RIDE IN THE PARK settled towards the rear, gained running four wide at the quarter pole, was all out coming to the wire and just got up grabbing third place in last jumps. SOME KINDA TROUBLE lagged far off the pace, trailed to the quarter pole, bid between foes in deep stretch, mildly improved placing but failed to factor. BOOYA SKEE DADDY saved ground throughout, mounted a mild bid turning for home, battled for a minor award from mid stretch but flattened out late. CRAFTY TIME stalked then chased to the far turn, dropped off near the quarter pole, finished spent.
