Footnotes

QUEEN OF FORTUNE stalked LETTER TO HENNY from the start, bid three wide drawing even turning for home, drove clear mid stretch and widened under aggressive handling. MEGHA settled in mid pack traveling between foes, swung out four wide taking aim on QUEEN OF FORTUNE in upper stretch, never threatened that rival but finished willingly picking up second place. LETTER TO HENNY set a rated pace racing in the two path, headed by the winner entering the stretch, proved no match from the eighth pole, weakened late holding onto third place. MY POWER BULLET well placed stalking along the rail, was hard ridden top of the stretch and throughout the lane but lacked needed response. WITHOUT A DREAM bumped with LEXIACOMO shortly after the start, trailed racing along the rail, slightly improved position but never menaced. LEXIACOMO bumped with WITHOUT A DREAM shortly after the start, trailed early racing mid track, hard ridden coming five wide into the stretch, showed little. SEEKING RICHES raced briefly in mid pack and off the rail, gave way near the quarter pole finishing spent.
