Footnotes

ALL TIZ rushed shortly after the start to vie for command, edged clear at the quarter pole, came out to the five path top of the lane, was under aggressive handling throughout the stretch drive holding safe to the finish. TAXICAB well placed early on, bid five wide on the turn, loomed outside the winner turning for home, was turned away mid stretch, proved a game second best. CRAFTY MATCH trailed along the inside to the quarter pole, angled out top of the stretch picking up momentum, closed willingly gaining a minor award. THE ONE TO CHASE settled along the rail tracking a quartet of duelers, angled out three wide top of the stretch, took aim on top pair mid stretch, failed to sustain move and leveled off needing more late. THREE MIRACLES lacked speed racing mid track, swung eight wide into the lane, mildly improved placing but never factored. SHORE TEE was hard used in the early stages vying for the lead, battled to the quarter pole, began to fade at the eighth pole, used up. MR. REGENT showed good speed, duelled for the lead racing between rivals on the bend, had enough in upper stretch and gave way. KWAME trailed soon after the start, lacked response when roused, never factored.
