Footnotes

UNCLE TOODIE duelled with THIS IS MY GAME to the quarter pole, drove clear and angled to the rail top of the lane, held a comfortable margin at the eighth pole, began to shorten stride in deep stretch but held safe as lead was quickly diminishing. THIS IS MY GAME hustled early and duelled with the winner to the quarter pole, could not keep pace turning for home, angled out to mid track and came again on a tiring winner nearing the finish, hard effort. EFFERVESCENT CHARM settled in the second flight, came six wide upper stretch, closed strongly in deep stretch to miss in a willing manner. PAULNPAUL well placed tracking throughout, hard ridden running towards the inside from top of the stretch, was outgamed late vying for a minor award. SIR ROMEO lacked speed and raced mid track, found best stride coming between rivals from mid stretch, finished with interest but never threatened. SINCERE MAN raced up close traveling four wide around the bend, failed to menace despite being hard ridden. GIFTS FOR A KING stalked top pair running along the rail to the quarter pole, started to drop off from mid stretch, no late factor. DAKOTA FREEWAY lacked speed and trailed to the quarter pole, failed to factor. MYSTIC MAZE dropped off to trail going around the turn, showed little in a dull try.
