MISTER BENTLEY tracked evenly through the backside firing to grab the lead on the far turn, angled from the three path to mid track a sixteenth out holding firm under a drive. DURANTS AFLEET unhurried for half advanced quickly on the far turn, pursued MISTER BENTLEY from mid track through the stretch holding well. MUFASA CAT stalked the pace through the backside, shuffled back on the far turn regrouped in upper stretch bidding evenly from the three and four path. PHIL C dropped back early laboring through the far turn, swung eight wide in upper stretch showed some late life on the far outside. MOONLIGHT GRAHAM tracked evenly along the inside to upper stretch hard roused in the two path had no surge. LITTLE TOP dropped off on the backside, labored racing six wide through the lane. CLEARED BY THE VET hustled clear led the way through the backside, passed on the far turn would wilt along the rail. KITE RUNNER hesitated then lunged leaving the gate, stayed back after.
