ESSENCE THUNDER stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the far turn, led in the two path upper stretch edging away under a drive. MASTER TASSEL pressured the pace wresting a short lead on the far turn, hooked on the inside to upper stretch proved no match holding to salvage place. MT. FUGI went evenly angling out five wide to upper stretch, improved a bit outbidding the others near mid track. BELLEOFTHEVALLEY raced second flight failing to menace. GOOD FAMILY played no factor. SAY DUBAI hustled out worked on pace dueling through the far turn, was used up entering the stretch. WAIKIKI was always outrun. ALRIGHT NOW showed little.
