Footnotes

MONEY SPITTER was hustled out pressuring the pace through the turn, dug deep on the inside of CHAMP DE MARS prevailing gamely. CHAMP DE MARS was sent hard pressing the pace three deep through the turn, locked up abreast MONEY SPITTER down the stretch giving all to no avail. HIEROGLYPHIC raced evenly through the turn coming five wide in upper stretch, extended at mid track made late headway. DOC THE LOCK broke alert pressuring the pace from between horses through the turn, would waver in upper stretch dropping off the last eighth. PERI PERI slow early came five wide to upper stretch angling seven wide there to hold position. BURNINLOVE slow early raced wide through the stretch posing no threat. DONERAILE'S PEAK was never involved. SNOWRAJ outrun early would tire. BE A PAL raced mid pack through the turn then folded in upper stretch. SHORE TEE labored throughout.
