Footnotes

SKY SISTER rushed down the backside and vied in a four way battle going into the far turn, took over entering the stretch and drew off from mid stretch being ridden out for a convincing victory. OH FIDDLESTIX hustled from the gate, battled to top of the lane running between foes, proved no match from the furlong marker, did well holding on to second place. POINT AND CLICK rushed down the backside, drew abreast vying for the lead traveling four wide at the three eighths pole, was outgamed in deep stretch, settled for third best in willing effort. NAKED PASSION pressed hard from the start, vied to the quarter pole running three wide and between foes, started to tire mid stretch, solid try. BIKINI raced up close going down the backside, had path taken away entering the far turn and took up losing position, chased from the quarter pole, came five wide under a drive entering the stretch, failed to threaten. FUHRBEE was squeezed at the break, took up and was outrun racing wide down the backside, never factored. RUNNERS DREAM broke out squeezing FUHRBEE at the start, settled towards the rear, gave way in upper stretch. A STEWARDS INQUIRY CONCERNING THE RUN GOING INTO THE FAR TURN RESULTED IN NO CHANGE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
