RAGING SEA broke alertly measuring on pace keeping a short lead through the turn, shook clear in the two path upper stretch digging in fully extended to hold. I'D MARRY ME laid close up through the turn looming abreast RAGING SEA in upper stretch, put to a stiff drive in the three then four path pressed the winner at the wire. DUBAI GLITTER away slowly was circled out to upper stretch, responded belatedly in the six path. NOT MY PROBLEM chased the pace through the turn extending in the three path upper stretch hanging late. D' BULLDOG breaking sharply pressured the pace along the inside through the turn then weakened near the rail down the stretch. KEEN AND WILD a step slow early angled to mid track in upper stretch finishing evenly. LIES AND AFFAIRS slow early was swung out six wide in upper stretch proving no menace. TRISKIN rushed up early pressured the pace three deep through the turn then wilted in the three path upper stretch.
