Footnotes

JUSTIN A STORM hustled out set the pace edging clear on the turn, digging from the three path drifted toward mid track holding firm late. SHARP BOURBON raced evenly through the turn coming six wide in upper stretch, found late surge getting up for place. STRATEGIC ZENNA ducked out at the break, tracked the pace through the turn, extending at mid track down the stretch would hang late. SEW SLIPPERY chased early then dropped off on the turn, saved ground to upper stretch bidding evenly near the rail. IN A MELLOW TONE pressed and chased through the turn extending to upper stretch, weakened late near mid track. PROUDTOBEALEADER slow early played no factor. TRUST N PATH veered out bumping at the break, was never involved. SHES A STEPPER bucked at the break staying back throughout. PACK ATTACK folded up on the turn.
