SPEEDSTER hustled to the top widened on lead through the turn, digging in near the rail upper stretch became leg weary late reaching the wire in time. SIX PACKEN PATTIE tracked evenly through the turn emerging in the four path upper stretch, surging abreast the tiring leader arrived a bit late. RISING SPIRIT varied little in mid pack through the turn, angled to mid track in upper stretch mustered enough to best the others. SKRAPES OF HOPE chased the pace through the turn then weakened in the three path upper stretch. HIT THE BOOKS slow early saved ground to upper stretch finishing evenly along the inside. JIVE' N JAZZ close early fell back on the turn. PRIVATE ELIZABETH played no factor finishing near mid track. BIG BOLD BRAT breaking slowly would race wide while always outrun. SISTER SERENA veered out checking at the break, trailed to upper stretch finishing eight wide. MISSY'S DOE slow early would tire along the inside.
