STALL JACK stalked PEACE AT LAST down the backside running along the inside, bid for the lead mid turn, drove clear leaving the quarter pole, widened on the field form mid stretch, won in hand as much the best. BLUE KIMONO settled in mid pack, saved ground around the turn, gained second place late but was no threat to the winner. PEACE AT LAST set the pace traveling off the rail, headed by the winner mid turn, had nothing left by mid stretch and gave way being outfinished for second place. SWINGING CHANGO lacked speed running towards the rear, improved placing in the lane but never factored. REMEMBER ME ADENA lagged far off the pace, found belated stride in upper stretch, passed some rivals running along the rail from mid stretch but never factored. CLEAR RECEPTION stumbled at the break, quickly recovered rushing up to stalk, loomed at the half running three wide, began to give way entering the stretch finishing spent. GOOD GRIEF tracked to the half, dropped off racing wide entering the stretch, well beaten. COLBY TAVERN raced wide in the second flight, showed little. INDY SIGNAL refused to break and the rider stepped off while INDY SIGNAL was attempting to finally leave the gate. BLUE KOMONO WAS DISQUALIFIED FROM SECOND TO UNPLACED DUE TO INELIGIBILITY.
