ALOTTA SPIRIT lunged from the gate, hustled to gain early position, followed hurried rivals through the turn, circled out drawing even abreast foes in mid drive, surged clear under stiff urging. DATE TREE BAY broke sharply to the top, worked a short lead into the turn under pressure from FLYING LEA, battled to the stretch when joined from the outside by ALOTTA SPIRIT, dug deep with good response ceding grudgingly late. ROSES FROM DORA outrun early, saved ground through the turn, set down inside the 1/4 pole, advanced in upper stretch, closed a strong factor near the rail. RARE HONOR a step slow off a contested pace, varied little moving evenly through the turn, swung out to mid track in upper stretch, lacked a needed surge in drive. FLYING LEA broke well following DATE TREE BAY into the turn, tried that one in extended fashion pressing to the 1/4 pole, turned away by rival in upper stretch, was wearing down between horses fading late. HELLO JUDY away slow, was outrun to the stretch proving no factor. WEST BOUND DREAM hustled with some speed, gave way soon after entering the turn. JET LINE struggled under early prompting, was put away at the head of the lane.
