Footnotes

UNSTOPPABLE MICK sat off a hotly contested pace, circled five wide entering the stretch, drew off easily under steady handling. FUHLANG broke alert, dueled throughout racing between foes, proved no match form mid stretch but held well saving second place. JERSEY DEVIL sent hard and dueled throughout racing three wide and between foes, tired mid stretch and settled for third place in a hard try. JAKES STORM BUCK settled in mid pack while saving ground, angled out six wide mid stretch, needed more late. LAGOON lacked speed racing mid track, came five wide into the lane, found best stride too late but never threatened. ACE JORDAN lacked speed racing towards the rear, showed belated action and was going well nearing the wire but never menaced. GREEN STORM pressed for the early lead, raced abreast at the quarter pole, gave way in mid stretch, used up. HUNGWITHOUTATRIAL lacked speed, offered little. WIND WHISPER was hard used vying for the early lead, stopped in mid stretch finishing spent.
