SOLOMAN'S GOLD broke alertly wrestling and nursing a short lead through the turn, shook clear in upper stretch widening under a drive. MUCHO GRANDIOSO stalked the pace pressing up to challenge on the turn, extending in the three path upper stretch was dispatched by the winner holding on to salvage place. LATE DOUBLE JACK hustled along bid four deep on the turn, drifted out to the seven path in upper stretch finishing evenly. KENTUCKY LIGHTNIN slow early varied little through the turn, mustered a mild response down the lane improving a bit in the three path. TRUST IN FRANK sent hard chased along the inside through the turn to upper stretch, extending on the rail came up short. INTERNATIONAL GUY broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, weakened near mid track in upper stretch. ARMED CONFLICT played no factor. COME ON KIP breaking slowly was never involved. SEEKING NOBILITY was always outrun. NEHALEM BAY broke slowly veering out after leaving the gate, trailed.
