Footnotes

WINE ANGEL was never far off the early pace running between foes on the turn, angled out to the four path upper stretch, slowly wore down DARTING in deep stretch going clear nearing the wire under strong encouragement. DARTING set a pressured pace traveling a little off the rail, held a clear advantage with a furlong to go, would be wore down nearing the wire missing in a very good effort. KISS THIS LOVE stalked down the backside, bid three wide to loom off the leader at the quarter pole, began to tire late while holding the show position. IM A BARGAIN saved ground traveling in the second flight, angled out mid stretch, mildly bid but never menaced. JILLS SUNSHINE lacked speed racing mid track, passed tiring foes in the lane never factoring. SMOKIN' BOOTS pressed for the early lead along the rail, remained a threat to upper stretch, was all done by the eighth pole fading to the wire. LADY MADCAP was always outrun, dull effort. LEMON PULP gave a brief chase, stopped upper stretch finishing weary.
