Footnotes

VALIENT TENOBOB pressed the pace dueling inside of CITIZEN'S ARREST through the turn, joined on the inside by SMOOTH DADDY RYAN in upper stretch would dig in between horses finding more at the end. SMOOTH DADDY RYAN stalked the pace saving ground to bid boldly along the rail in upper stretch, extending inside of VALIENT TENOBOB the final eighth proved willing though no match. VAN LEROY was jammed by SWAP UP steadying back at the break, hustled to recover came six wide into upper stretch angling in a bit finishing well. CITIZEN'S ARREST broke sharply pressuring the pace alongside VALIENT TENOBOB through the turn, battling into upper stretch would wear from use late in the three path. UNIQUELY was jammed when SWAP UP bore out steadying back at the break, played no factor after. SWAP UP bore out leaving the gate impeding rivals in the process, showed brief foot then retreated on the turn. AVOID gave hard pursuit through the turn then wore out near mid track in upper stretch. ASSIPATTLE faded back on the turn.
