PENITANT PRAYERS settled in good tracking position, angled five wide into the stretch, put to severe left handed whip for the drive, wore down VENTURE CAPITAL in last jump being fully extended. VENTURE CAPITAL broke alertly and set all the pace, held an apparent safe lead with a furlong to go, would be nailed on the wire missing in a hard effort. BENNY HALL rated early on, roused leaving the quarter pole, rallied six wide top of the lane, closed willingly in a good effort. KEEN COURT pressed the runner up to mid turn running along the rail, started to chase entering the stretch, lacked late kick and tired for the eighth pole besting rest. LIES AND AFFAIRS settled in the second flight racing wide around the bend, gave belated action to improve but was no real threat. LOCKE THE DOC raced up close to the quarter pole, weakened entering the stretch and was no factor in the drive. BIG BOY ARTIE rushed bid going into the far turn, held a menacing position at the quarter pole, flattened out in upper stretch. COSTA BLANCA raced in mid pack traveling four wide, failed to respond when asked and tired in the lane. BARONIAL lacked speed never factoring. BEAT MICHIGAN was always outrun, dull effort.
