FUDGELUV stalked early on, bid three wide mid turn, drove clear entering the stretch, drifted out in deep stretch despite being under the right handed stick, just lasted, fully extended. ONE SHOT AT A TIME was bumped by INDY'S CHARGE leaving the gate, settled towards the rear, advanced mid turn, angled out mid stretch, surged nearing the wire to just miss in a hard effort. THE RIDER OF ONE SHOT AT A TIME CLAIMED FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF FUDGELIV CITING INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH, AFTER REVIEWING THE TAPE, THE STEWARDS DISMISSED THIS CLAIM. SKYANGLE was bumped and took up briefly shortly after the start, trailed in the early stages, swung five wide top of the lane, bid willingly securing the third place. STARSHIP SAPPHIRE was bumped by INDY'S CHARGE shortly after the start, rushed four wide into the first turn, set the pace for six furlongs, battled to upper stretch, ceded in the final eighth, good try. INDY'S CHARGE broke outwards bumping rivals, settled towards the rear, made a bold four wide mid turn, chased entering the stretch, leveled off mid stretch needing more late. AT HEAVENS DOOR hustled from the gate, raced five wide into the first turn, tracked to the half, bean to fade leaving the quarter pole. DISPUTE FORGOTTEN trailed at the half racing mid track, urged on the bend, offered little never factoring. PAVAROTTI MISS was forwardly placed from the start, raced up close to midway on the second turn, began to tire past the quarter pole, no factor in the stretch. MALOU'S MAGIC hustled leaving the gate and pressed briefly for the early lead, steadily retreated from the three eighths pole finishing well beaten.
