STARSHIP ROMEO quickly gained control entering the first turn, set a nicely rated pace traveling in the two path, was threatened by ANARCHY near the quarter pole, responded to pressure to thwart that rival and drew off from mid stretch having more. ANARCHY stalked to the far turn, rallied three wide mid turn to loom off the winner, was turned away and settle for second best in a good try. PORTRATURE rated early racing in the second flight, rallied along the inside in upper stretch, moved into third place giving chase but needed more besting rest. GO BRAY BOO raced evenly in mid pack running a little off the rail, swung out four wide under a drive into the lane, mildly bid but was no real threat. GRAY WAGON tracked down the backside racing four to five wide, roused to no avail mid turn, failed to menace. POWERMOUSE lacked speed running towards the rear, showed some late interest improving position but never factored. LAGOON was forwardly placed early on running along the rail, remained a threat to the quarter pole, started to fade in upper stretch. STOW IT stalked then vied briefly at the half, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, finished spent. A BREW IN TH WOODS raced evenly towards the rear offering little. MR. MARCH was always outrun in a dull performance.
