Footnotes

SENTIMENTAL was patiently handled going down the backside, rallied four wide engaging LA SUPREMA for the lead entering the stretch, edged clear inside the eighth pole and was kept to steady pressure holding sway. REMEMBERYOURPLACE rated and raced towards the rear traveling well off the rail, came five wide top of the lane, put to strong left handed stick and responded in deep stretch to surge gaining the place position late. LA SUPREMA broke alertly and quickly cleared setting the pace, traveled off the rail throughout, fought gamely once headed in upper stretch, drifted over to the rail with a furlong to go, did hold well saving the show position. MORNING PRAYERS settled in good tracking position, bid between foes mid stretch, loomed in tandem with a sixteenth to go, would hang late being outfinished for minor awards. SUNDAYINTHESOUTH lacked speed and raced mid track, failed to respond when asked, no threat. DEMANDING showed good speed, stalked along the rail to the quarter pole, was all done mid stretch and weakened to the wire. ROYAL SNEAK quickly faded leaving the far turn, was eased to the finish line.
