Footnotes

TOES ON THE CURB raced up close stalking a hotly contested pace, came thru along the rail top of the stretch, raced in close quarters from mid stretch, led late and prevailed under good handling. SIZZLIN PRINCESS sent hard, duelled early on racing two wide, battled with the winner to the wire, was out nodded just missing in a very game effort. BONSAI stalked around the bend, bid four wide racing between foes top of the lane, matched strides to the sixteenth pole, tired late. LITTLE MISS SIX was never far off the pace, rallied five wide and almost drew even in upper stretch, started to tire inside the eighth pole, besting rest. FAST KISSER settled in the second flight, rallied splitting foes mid stretch, improved placing but never menaced. MEMORIES OF GEORGE raced evenly in the second flight, swung six wide entering the stretch, lacked needed surge. LIEU DIT sent hard from the gate, alternated for the lead racing three wide and belated foes around the turn, began to fade mid stretch, used up. POKER GIRL tracked the pace traveling four wide, failed to respond never threatening. EVIL MONEY lacked speed racing mid track, came eight wide upper stretch under a drive, showed little. PRIMA SIGNORA was in tight shortly after the start causing the rider to take up, trailed the field racing wide throughout, offered little.
