Footnotes

DEPUTY SPARKS broke alertly measuring on a short lead through the far turn, drew off in upper stretch being ridden out in the two path. AFLAIR moved on pace shadowing DEPUTY SPARKS through the far turn, dispatched by the winner in upper stretch held up for place in the three path. SIR DEPUTY tracked the pace through the far turn angling out to upper stretch, weakened late at mid track. THOMAS IS ROCKIN unhurried early circled out threatening five deep on the far turn, wavered into upper stretch fading in the six path. LUSTERDUST stalked close up through the far turn then came up short in the two path down the stretch. PLEASANTLY GOLD went evenly for half a mile then folded on the far turn, was put away mid stretch. ALL THE GLORY chased early then wilted abruptly after a half mile.
