HIGH CANADIAN broke alert cutting across crowding rivals after the break, hustled clear on the turn digging in near the rail down the stretch, tested in the final yards held on to late pressure. GO R V GO crowded after the break steadied briefly, stalked to upper stretch angling from the four path to the two path bearing down at the wire missing gamely. NATIVE NIKO brushed early would pressure the pace into the turn, dropped off there racing evenly along the inside the rest of the way to best the others. ARASHI CAT cut off early would mount a bid racing four wide on the turn, drifted out to the six path in upper stretch weakening the final eighth. KEEN CASE away slowly was outrun through the turn swinging six wide in upper stretch. MEGA WONDER dropping back early played no factor. THERE WERE A PAIR OF OBJECTIONS FROM THE RIDERS OF GO R V GO AND ARASHI CAT AGAINST THE RIDER OF HIGH CANADIAN FOR INTERFERENCE AFTER THE START. THE GO R V GO OBJECTION WAS UPHeld AND HIGH CANADIAN WAS DISQUALIFIED AND PLACED SECOND.
