Footnotes

ON THE DEFENSIVE veered in brushing the gate at the break, rushed along between horses into the turn, angled out inside the 1/4 pole, collared MACKINAW ISLAND from the outside in upper stretch, edged away in drive. MACKINAW ISLAND broke alertly to press the pace, dueled alongside PERSIAN PRINCESS through the turn, subdued that one then was quickly collared from the outside by ON THE DEFENSIVE in upper stretch, fought back inside the 1/16 pole before ceding grudgingly late. I HEAR A SYNPHONY went a step slow early, roused 4 wide on the turn, gave a mild rally into upper stretch, went evenly the final 1/16 to outbid others. SENORITA ECHO sent hard on the outside, pressed full out 4 wide through the turn, extended for more 5 wide down the lane, gradually wore down under the whip. HATCHETSFLYINGIRL broke alertly, was outrun for the early lead, pursued on the inside through the turn, angled out in upper stretch, weakened the final 1/8. PERSIAN PRINCESS sent hard for the early lead, battled inside of MACKINAW ISLAND through the turn, folded up near the rail in drive. STORM OF THE WEST was never involved. LITTLE LIL away slowly, showed little. LILY MARTINI reared up at the break, dropped well back having a laboring journey.
