Footnotes

TRAJECTORY MIST raced up close from the start, bid in tandem at the quarter pole, vied in a four way battle entering the stretch, was put to an all out drive from the furlong marker, slowly inched clear nearing the wire being fully extended. LITTLE BOBBER hustled from the gate, vied for the lead around the turn, dug in from top of the lane being headed from both sides, ceded the lead in deep stretch missing in a very determined effort. DOWNONMAINSTREET stalked throughout running along the rail, advanced mid stretch putting a head in front, fought hard to the wire but was outgamed in last strides. IT'S GOTTA BE US rated early sitting in the second flight, launched bid angling four wide inside the eighth pole, surged at the wire finishing strongly but ran out of real estate. TELL IT TO MYHEART trailed early, swung six wide into the stretch, found stride too late giving belated action, never menaced. WINTER KNIGHT rushed a four wide move mid turn, drew even traveling four wide at the quarter pole, could not keep pace from mid stretch and weakened to the finish line. T P MINT raced evenly while saving ground throughout, asked top of the lane, lacked response and weakened to the wire.
