**Footnotes**

TIE rushed mid turn and headed HIGH WAGER, went clear near the quarter pole, angled towards the rail upper stretch, widened from the eighth pole winning ridden out. TOSCA'S KISS tracked to the quarter pole, swung five wide entering the lane, chased the winner to mid stretch, leveled off while holding on to second place. HIGH WAGER broke sharply, set a pressured pace traveling a little off the rail, headed by the winner mid turn, proved no match from mid stretch, weakened late and just lasted for the show position. CONNIE'S JUNE MOON raced in good tracking position to the quarter pole, made a bold bid entering the stretch, raced between foes mid stretch, leveled off being outfinished for a minor award. BAGATELLE TERRACE raced along the rail while not far off the early pace, was briefly in tight leaving the far turn, angled out to the six path top of the stretch, lacked rally despite being hard ridden. PRINCESS ADITI lacked speed racing mid track, roused to no avail. TRUE JAZZ flashed brief foot, began to fade mid turn, well beaten.
