CANADIAN SHADOW patiently ridden running in the second flight, gained from mid turn, rallied along the rail and collared SUNSHINE SMOKEY in upper stretch, drew clear inside the furlong marker, won drawing off under steady urging. FABRICATE set the pace running in the two path, headed in upper stretch, battled to mid stretch then could not keep pace, dug in late saving second place in a hard effort. BLUE KING settled in mid pack, rallied four wide into the lane, finished willingly saving third place under strong handling. LANGFUHR GLORY lacked speed trailing down the backside, angled out mid turn, swung five wide upper stretch, leveled off late needing more. CLOUDY VISION unhurried and trailed at the half, split foes on the bend making move, gave chase from upper stretch needing more late. MISTRIAL tracked to the far turn, gave chase in the bend running between foes, lacked rally and tired in the drive. SUNSHINE SMOKEY stalked the winner to the quarter pole, began to fade turning for home, finished spent. PASCHAR raced towards the inside in the second flight, failed to respond never menacing. YOUR A TO Z'S was forwardly placed racing along the rail, began to drop off coming to the quarter pole finishing weary. PERFECT TRIANGLE raced briefly in mid pack, faded from the half, was eased on the bend but did complete the course.
