Footnotes

SERRATED EDGE pressured the pace inside of rivals through the turn, shook clear in the three path upper stretch holding firm from the eighth pole. RUNNING WISH slow early emerged to threaten five wide in upper stretch, gave steady surge at mid track getting up for place. TONY LANTANA broke alertly pressuring from between horses through the turn, ceding to SERRATED EDGE in upper stretch angled from the three to the four path going evenly in the final yards. BEAR'S CONDUCTOR chased the pace through the turn coming four wide in upper stretch, angled inside near the eighth pole would hold position. RIO STAR hustled out would pressure the pace racing three deep through the turn then weaken in the four path upper stretch. TEST MARKET played no factor. M. J.'S COMMANDER was never involved. STOW IT was always outrun. POLITE LIL SIR gave early retreat struggling throughout.
