HOUSE OF PRAYER perfectly placed tracking a hotly contested pace, urged leaving the quarter pole, angled to the four path taking aim top of the stretch, raced abreast vying for the lead at the eighth pole, slowly inched clear coming to the wire for a hard earned victory. FOREVER SHARP rushed from the gate, dueled in a three way battle soon after the start, matched strides to deep stretch, ceded grudgingly in last jumps missing in a very solid effort. NORTHERN JET hustled to duel for the lead racing three wide mid turn, battled to deep stretch, weakened late while just saving the show position in a game try. PEEKABOO VISION broke well dueling for the lead, edged clear at the quarter pole, was collared in mid stretch from both sides, was outfinished late missing the show position. ADMIRAL BAILEY settled in the second flight, angled a bit inside entering the stretch, raced in close with NATIVE SENSATION throughout the stretch run, failed to menace. NATIVE SENSATION raced along the rail running in the second flight, raced a bit in tight from upper stretch, failed to respond, no threat. GO FOR CAMERON was taken up shortly after the start, angled to the rail soon after, roused while angling out top of the stretch, lacked surge, no threat. UPTONOW was always outrun offering little. INNOVATIVE FASHION made an early fade, no factor.
