TRICKY SURPRISE sat in good tracking position while 4 wide, asked near 1/4 pole, bid into lane and drove clear mid stretch, pulled away late. HOUSTON HUSTLER came away in good stalking order, pressed on the turn, held small lead in upper stretch, battled inside of TRICKY SURPRISE to deep stretch, was no match late but held gamely for place. LEAH'S LOOK went evenly early, asked and angled wide top of the lane, surged too late, willing. TOO MANY CHOICES sent hard to set a pressured pace along the rail, battled to upper stretch then began to weaken from there. TSU TSU WON was well place racing 4 wide on the turn, asked for more but came up empty in the drive. PRINCESS PEAK stalked along the rail, eased out near the 1/4 pole, bid and vied for the lead in upper stretch, weakened mid stretch racing between rivals. BEWITCHING EYES went evenly early, angled upper stretch, asked but needed more in the drive. YA LATEEFAH had no speed racing wide throughout, roused under left handed stick in upper stretch and drifted wider mid lane, no factor.
