KYLE'S TREASURY rushed and battled early on racing between rivals, put a head in front in upper stretch, held firm under steady handling. GALLOPIN GROOM vied in a three way duel racing along the rail, ceded stubbornly in deep stretch., game effort. OFFICER OF THE DAY rushed and vied while three to four wide around the bend, matched strides to upper stretch, yielded grudgingly. EL CIESTO rated early, raced towards the inside, hard ridden into the stretch, improved position but was no real threat. POT LIMIT tracked running five wide down the backside, asked for more, failed to respond. MEAN STREETS raced in mid pack traveling six wide early, never menaced. KARAMANDUKA raced in the second flight at mid track, came into the lane racing between foes, failed to threaten. PLAY FOR SARATOGA outrun early, managed to pass weary foes, never factored. FLANKED IN GOLD broke late, rushed to mid pack racing well off the rail, chased to the quarter pole, faded entering the stretch. UNSTABLE outrun early, never involved.
