SHADY LADY SAIDIE hustled to the top, set a well rated pace, headed by ALY'S COLORS and lost the lead briefly at the quarter pole, responded to strong handling entering the stretch to go clear mid stretch, won convincingly under a drive. MY SWEET VIOLET stalked the winner racing at mid track, sat patient to the quarter pole, angled out five wide entering the stretch, finished willingly to secure the place position. SPIRIT OF FIRE rated early, saved ground throughout, hard ridden leaving the quarter pole, improved placing but needed more in deep stretch. ALY'S COLORS rated early, rallied between foes at the half, took a head lead outside of SHADY LADY SAIDIE at the quarter pole, failed to sustain bid, flattened out mid stretch. DANCING PHOENIX lagged for three quarters, swung seven wide under a stiff drive into the stretch, mildly closed ground, no real factor. FAIRYTALE DIAMOND lacked speed, roused mid turn, failed to menace, no factor. SCALD well placed early, stalked the winner to the half, urged far turn, had no response, gave way leaving the quarter pole.
