Footnotes

INHERENTLY dueled briefly for the early lead, moved clear mid turn, angled to the rail in upper stretch and widened on the field, won easily being in hand. ITINERARY tracked to mid turn, roused angling to the rail top of the lane, chased the winner in the lane but never threatened finishing a willing second. CITY BEAR dueled with the winner in the early going, could not keep pace leaving the quarter pole, angled to mid track giving chase in upper stretch, tired in mid stretch but managed to just save the show position. PHILOLOGY raced sluggishly trailing to the quarter pole, angled out to the six path in upper stretch, hit stride and finished full of run at the finish narrowly missing third place. RAY FROM CLAY lacked speed running in the second flight, mildly bid along the inside upper stretch, leveled off never threatening. SOLDIER BILL hustled to race up close to the quarter pole, was all done in upper stretch fading to the wire. SMOKY FOUR was a step slow into stride, raced three to four wide around the bend under urging, lacked response and weakened in the drive. I'M SERIOUS lacked speed running towards the rear, gave way leaving the quarter pole finishing well beaten.
