**Footnotes**

HE'S A DIXIE BOY stalked down the backside racing a little off the rail, came three wide at the quarter pole to vie for the lead, drove clear in upper stretch, won easily being kept to task. BAY BUTTON BILL settled in the second flight, asked mid turn and came four wide entering the stretch, closed willingly picking up the place position. SLIVER trailed to the far turn racing off the rail, swung six wide top of the lane, hit stride and finished strongly gaining third place. SOUTHERN TWISTER settled in the second flight and saved ground to top of the lane, angled out under a drive, mildly improved but failed to menace. GROUP EFFORT stumbled at the break, quickly recovered rushing up to press the pace racing along the rail, battled gamely to upper stretch, weakened inside the eighth pole. THE ONE TO CHASE sent hard and cleared soon after the start, was pressured by GROUP EFFORT after the opening furlong, dueled around the turn running two wide, had enough and gave way mid stretch. SAY NEW YORK SANDY staked running four wide early on, failed to respond when asked for more and weakened in the lane. DELAWARE SLEW was always outrun racing wide throughout, offered little. IAM DIXIE stalked early traveling three to four wide, dropped off past the quarter pole, used up. ANNIKA'S LOVE lacked speed and gave way top of the lane offering little.
