SUNDANCE RICHIE prompted the pace through the turn shaking off HIGH ACT to go clear in upper stretch, angling from the two to the three path held sway the final eighth. OLYMPIC STREET stalked the pace through the turn angling to mid track in upper stretch, though willing under a drive proved second best. BATON ROUGE slow early gave a mild rally in the four path down the stretch outbidding the others. HIGH ACT broke sharply pressuring the pace through the turn, weakened in upper stretch dropping to the rail with little left late. HEADLINE dropped from contention on the turn. BUDDHA CAN DANCE was never involved racing six wide through the stretch. PATRICK N DYLAN chased early then gave way on the turn. EL WINDO was always outrun.
