NAE PROBLEM nicely rated traveling mid pack towards the inside, urged midway on the second turn, rallied three wide leaving the quarter pole, drew even with a pair of rivals mid stretch, raced abreast to the wire, slowly inched up in last jumps for a hard earned victory. BILL'S THRILL stalked the leader from the start, gained turning for home, vied for the lead racing between foes from the eighth pole, was out nodded missing in a very hard effort. SWEDISH BEAUTY quickly showed in front, set all the pace running along the inside, headed by the runner up in upper stretch, then the winner joined in at the eighth pole, battled in a three way duel to the wire, ceded grudgingly missing in a very determined effort. MINON settled in the second flight, came five wide under an aggressive drive upper stretch, needed more late besting rest. VANA B well placed saving ground throughout, began to chase from mid turn, lacked rally and weakened in the lane. I'LL FIND YOU varied little running mid pack, lacked response, no threat. SPECIAL VICTORY was always outrun, never involved. DAZZLE N THRILL lacked speed offering little. DECEMBER DIVA broke well stalking from the start, rushed a three wide move at the half to press for the lead, could not keep pace from the three eighths pole, faded from there. SUNSET SUMMER reared at the break, lagged early on, dropped further off leaving the far turn, dull effort.
