Footnotes

DEPUTY DIRECTOR was forwardly placed, bid near the quarter pole, came four wide entering the stretch, headed DOCALOT mid stretch, drew off late under strong handling. DOCALOT broke alertly, set all the pace around the turn, collared by DEPUTY DIRECTOR mid stretch, fought hard to deep stretch, yielded and then was extended to save the place position. AMPHIBIOUS ASSAULT settled early, advanced near the quarter pole, loomed in upper stretch racing five wide, finished willingly. SNOWRAJ raced in good tracking position, saved ground throughout, hard ridden from upper stretch, needed more late. LORE OF THE ROAD was hustled along, gave chase traveling four wide, failed to menace in the drive. MR. BEHRENS lacked speed, trailed to the quarter pole, swung seven wide into the lane, gained belatedly but was no real threat. CAST NO SHADOW was urged leaving the gate, failed to respond, settled in the second flight, mildly improved placing but was no factor. HIT IT SKIP raced wide around the turn, never threatened. FIVE AND OFF flashed speed and pressed the runner up briefly, began to fade leaving the quarter pole, never factored in the stretch run. STORM SEARCH was always outrun, offered little.
