Footnotes

ALLENSWORTH was in tight and briefly steadied at the seven eighths pole, settled in good stalking position, drew even with TWO CATS leaving the quarter pole, gained a slim lead mid stretch and angled to the rail causing TWO CATS to take up briefly, dug in late under an all out drive. BROTHER RON was rated running along the inside to midway on the second turn, gained near the quarter pole and angled out three wide taking aim on the pacesetters, slowly cut into the margin from the furlong marker, missed late in a hard effort. TWO CATS went to the front going into the first turn, set a solid pace running a little off the rail, headed by the winner top of the lane, lost the lead mid stretch and had to steady briefly a sixteenth out when ALLENSWORTH drifted in, tried to re-rally late, very game try. CAPTURED RED MAGIC hopped at the break and raced towards the rear, beat weary foes never factoring. FARLEYSHELONWHEELS lagged far off the pace and was never involved. SMARTTHINKIN'TONY was a bit rank in the early stages stalking the pace running towards the inside, finally moved out to mid track leaving the far turn starting to chase, lacked response and faded from the quarter pole. KEEP THE CHIEF tracked the pace traveling four wide to the half, dropped off coming to the quarter pole, well beaten. A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN RESULTED IN NO CHANGE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
