SUNSHINE BO set a well rated pace running along the inside, responded when called upon mid stretch, dug in winning in a game effort. DREAM VICTORY rated and trailed to the half, angled on the bend, made a four wide bid entering the stretch, loomed off the winner from mid stretch, needed a bit more late but won the battle for second place. CRAFTY MARK settled racing mid track, rallied four wide mid turn, loomed off the winner top of the lane, fought hard running between foes mid stretch, was edged out of second place nearing the wire. DANCE WORLD raced in good tracking position traveling two wide, was in tight from mid stretch vying for a minor award, outfinished late. THE BIG HIGHROLLER was never far off the pace, saved ground throughout, was outfinished late fighting for a minor placing. COUNTRY HUMOR stalked to mid turn racing between rivals at the quarter pole, began to fade in upper stretch, used up. MT. ORIENT showed brief foot, began to drop off coming to the quarter pole, finished well beaten.
