CLAY BASKET rushed up stalking the pace going into the far turn, dueled mid turn racing three wide, went clear upper stretch and increased margin being ridden out for an easy victory. MARICELA PRINCESS broke in bumping with HARLAN LIGHT leaving the gate, sent up along the inside to vie for the early lead, battled to the three sixteenths, proved no match in the lane and just saved second place under strong encouragement. HARLAN LIGHT broke out bumping with MARICELA PRINCESS, moved back to the rail hustling up to stalk, held a menacing position at the quarter pole, put to a drive entering the stretch, lacked needed punch and needed a bit more late being out nodded for second place. TOUGH SOUP hoped as the gate opened then ducked inward, raced greenly in the early stages racing wide around the turn, did find belated stride to finish with interest but failed to factor. SMILING PLACE broke well and vied for the early lead running three wide and between foes to middle of the turn, gave way entering the stretch, stopped near the eighth pole finishing spent.
